



2018 RWDC A Show Specifications

1. These are separate shows using RWDC A classes and for Red & Whites only.
2. The RWDC A will accept original registration papers and/or a certificate of identification (CID) from Holstein Association USA. Other registration papers accepted will be from RWDC A, Holstein Association USA showing the suffix "RED" and Holstein Canada.
3. All owners shown on registration paper must be a member in good standing of RWDC A.
4. Animals must be Red and White in color.
5. If for any reason an animal is in question for eligibility, the RWDC A management will be contacted before a final decision is rendered.
6. Eligibility of animals and RWDC A members will be determined on a show to show basis.
7. In order to enter/exhibit at any national and/or approved shows, Red & White animals must carry 87% dairy bloodlines as designated by RWDC A guidelines. Dairy bloodlines include: Ayrshire, Brown Swiss, Guernsey, Holstein (Black & White and Red & White), Jersey, Milking Shorthorn, Angler, Swedish Red, Aussie Red, Lineback and Rouge Flammande.
8. RWDC A will assist show management determining membership status with a list of entries one week prior to the show.
9. All requirements listed above must be met 24 hours before the start of the show.
10. Following the show, show management must provide RWDC A with a report that lists all placings, champions, etc, within 30 days, regardless of show status.
11. After RWDC A receives the national show report, with individual class placings and champion information, the results will be entered into the animal's permanent record.
